### **DeLand DMV branch to close for renovations beginning April 3**

**DeLand, Fla.** – The DeLand branch of the Office of Will Roberts – Tax Collector, located on the first floor of the Thomas C. Kelly Administration Building, 123 W. Indiana Ave., DeLand, will temporarily close for renovations beginning 3 p.m., April 2. During the renovation period, no driver license, tag and title or other motorist services will be available at this location. The property tax department will remain open for non-cash payments only.

“This renovation will enhance our operations to meet current and future demand,” said Volusia County Tax Collector Will Roberts. “Our DeLand main office currently handles nearly twice the weekly average number of transactions than the other branches – 2,276 compared to 1,212. These improvements will improve operational efficiency and add services for customer convenience while also improving access for our customers.”

The DeLand branch is anticipated to reopen upon project completion on Nov. 1. This timeline is optimistic, and the office will work diligently to meet it, Roberts added.

Customers needing driver license or motor vehicle services during the temporary closure have several options:

The renovation project will modernize the branch to better serve the growing community and improve the customer experience. Plans include:

- A redesigned lobby with improved traffic flow and ADA accessibility
- Expanded customer seating
- Additional services, including driver license (DL) and commercial driver license (CDL) written exams
- Updated testing and work areas designed for efficiency and comfort
- Enhanced technology infrastructure

The County of Volusia is funding and managing the project, as Florida statute requires the county to provide an office for the tax collector in the county seat. The total project cost is estimated at \$1.2 million, including design and construction.
